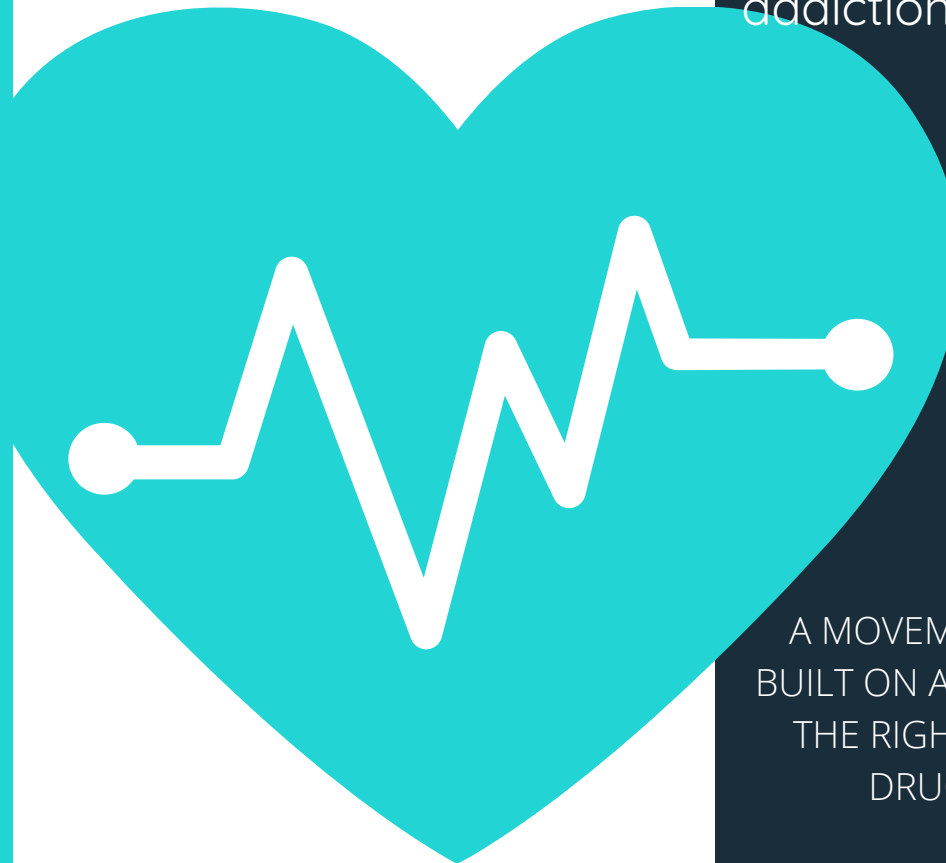

COMMUNITY BASED STRATEGY

1) Proactive Outreach to known substance users. Involves the police department Outreach Coordinator or Outreach Liaison reaching out to substance users to support them in developing a plan to ensure survival, to facilitate the long-term process of recovery, & to assist substance users & their loved ones to services.

2) Wareham Community Outreach involves a series of community based meetings co-facilitated by the Wareham Police departments Outreach Coordinator & a community substance abuse intervention expert aimed at achieving treatment goals and with creating a supportive non-judgemental environment for substance users & their families. A neutral & Confidential setting is of utmost importance and afforded at all times.
